2024 PERFORMANCE COMMITTEE UPDATES

The busy season is definitely gearing up for the Alumni Pep Bands!

- Spring kicks off with the Gold Blue Spring Game on Saturday, April 27th and the Summer Gig Schedule is already filling up.
- The TBT Basketball Tourney will be in Pittsburgh July 19 24. We are awaiting the game draw for specific dates and times. This move to Pittsburgh gives our members from eastern Ohio, Pennsylvania, and Maryland more opportunities to participate. We have a Digital Pep Band Library online with links to rehearsal tracks so we can play more repertoire both on our own and at joint events with The Pride.





2024 WVU ALUMNI BAND - Michigan Tour "A Tribute to Don Wilcox"

On July 11-14, 2024, members of the WVU Alumni Band will be traveling to Northport, Michigan to honor our beloved Director of Bands Emeritus Don Wilcox. Mr. Wilcox, who currently resides in Northport, served as WVU's Director of Bands for 34 years - 27 of these years were as the Director of the WVU Marching Band. This special trip will culminate with a tribute concert to honor the legacy of the man who set the standard for what the West Virginia University Band program is today!

The anticipated 75-member concert band will rehearse in Morgantown on July 10, and then depart for Michigan on July 11. After an overnight in Detroit (with some sightseeing), the group will depart for Northport for the Friday evening, July 12 concert. July 13 will be a day spent at the popular Mackinac Island in northern Michigan; the group will then return to West Virginia on July 14.

Personnel for the ensemble ranges from all ages and talent abilities – spanning the decades Mr. Wilcox spent at WVU. Several younger band alumni who simply want to honor Mr. Wilcox will also be participating. It is anticipated that a few members of the Northport Community Band, which Mr. Wilcox conducted for years, will perform alongside our members for the concert. Plans are currently underway for the music selection for the concert. It is anticipated that music will feature selections that Mr. Wilcox enjoys – including a medley of WVU fight songs arranged for concert band by Mr. Wilcox. Various marches, light-hearted selections, and other concert band pieces will also be programmed. The concert will certainly be wonderful way to honor a man that means so much to us all.

Earlier this month, members who have registered received an email from Jeff Caplinger about the tour, which included a more detailed itinerary, update on music to practice, specific information about the performance (including attire), and other necessary details. Jeff Caplinger's tour company (All About Destinations) is organizing the details of the tour; John Hendricks is organizing the concert performance.
